### Objective

### Duties and Responsibilities

#### To generate leads for the Teach For Malaysia Fellowship

- Have compelling conversations with potential candidates and encourage them to sign up to receive further information about opportunities at Teach For Malaysia.
- Refer high potential candidates in your university or someone you know to a recruiter.
- Independently organise your own events on campus to generate leads for the Fellowship.
- Lead or support Teach For Malaysia recruitment events such as career fairs, career talk, lecture shouts or pitches.

#### To raise awareness about the Teach For Malaysia brand and movement

- Design your own methods to increase brand awareness and visibility at your university through a variety of marketing strategies (e.g. video, posters, flyers) to highlight the Fellowship as one of the best opportunities at your university.
- Generate brand awareness through word-of-mouth marketing and student media channels.
- Participate in event marketing by promoting the brand through various social media accounts.

#### To build partnerships with various stakeholders

- Be the point of contact for students in your university and represent the brand positively in multitude setting
- Connect Teach For Malaysia to key influencers on campus
- Drive forward new stakeholder relationships and building on existing ones with lecturers, a diverse range of university societies, the Students' Union and your careers advisory service.

#### General recruitment support

- Provide general support across Teach For Malaysia programs such as donation and recruitment campaigns, where required.
- Provide feedback and insight on best recruitment strategies suitable for your university.
- Help recruiter to understand the student market in your university.

- Must be enrolled at a university in Malaysia or abroad.

- Previous experience as a student ambassador or campus representative (preferred, but not compulsory).
